Heard learned counsel for the parties on the application preferred for temporary suspension of sentence on the ground that applicant's mother is suffering from illness in L-6 & L-7 of the backbone and she needs to be treated at a higher center.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that there is no other male member in the family to take care about well-being of the applicant's mother therefore, the application for temporary suspension of sentence may be allowed for a period of four weeks.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor has verified the factum of applicant's mother suffering from problem in backbone and the fact that there is no other male member in the family to take care about the well-being of the applicant's mother.

4. We have considered the submissions made at the bar and have gone through the relevant record of the case.

5. In view of the aforesaid, the present application seeking temporary suspension of sentence is allowed and it is ordered that the substantive sentence vide judgment dated 05.09.2024 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bhadra, District Hanumangarh in Session Case No.14/2018 against the applicant – **Vikram Singh S/o Shri Jagdish Prasad**, shall remain temporarily suspended for a period of four weeks from the date of his actual release provided he executes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Only) with two sureties in the sum of Rs.50,000/-(Rupees Fifty Thousand Only) out of which one surety will be of his close relative, each to the satisfaction of the concerned Jail Superintendent on usual conditions. He shall surrender back before the concerned Jail Superintendent after completion of four weeks from the date of his actual release. The concerned Jail Superintendent shall give a date of his surrender.

6. Let this application seeking interim suspension of sentence be again listed on 27.03.2026, and on that date, learned Public Prosecutor and learned counsel for the petitioner shall submit the compliance of this order.
