1. The petitioner has filed this bail application under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.70/2025 registered at Police Station Bhojasar, District Phalodi for offence under Sections 8/22 29 of NDPS Act.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that though there is allegation against the co-accused Sukhram for possession of 14.65 gram MDMA which is above commercial quantity, but as per the FSL report dated 21.08.2025 the contraband was found to be mephedrone and as per the NDPS Act, the commercial quantity of mephedrone is more than 50 gram. Hence, the quantity of recovered contraband mephedrone allegedly recovered in this matter is below commercial quantity. it

is further submitted that the co-accused Sukhram and Ramchandra got benefit of bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court on 04.09.2025 and 17.09.2025 respectively. He again submits that the petitioner is behind the bars since 12.02.2026 with one antecedent of different nature. The trial of the case may take considerable time and no further custodial interrogation is required, hence on the ground of parity, the bail application of the petitioner may be allowed.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application.

5. On consideration of the rival submissions and material available on record and in the light of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner especially on the ground of parity but without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioner.

6. Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner **Prem Prakash S/o Babu Ram**, be released on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that he shall appear before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing till conclusion of the trial.
