Order

1. Present writ petition has been filed challenging the condition and requirement of Bank Guarantee of Rs. 25,00,000/- for release of original documents for candidates joining Institutes of National Importance (INI) for Senior Residents.
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in case of similarly situated candidates, this Court at Jaipur Bench, in ***S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 18011/2025*** titled ***Dr.***

Harshpreet Kour & Ors. vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors., has passed a detailed interim order dated 10.02.2026 and directed State Government to release original document(s) of said candidates on submission of an undertaking.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that as a matter of fact, petitioner, at the time of admission in PG course, had submitted a bond/undertaking to serve the State of Rajasthan for two years. Terms of said service bond further stipulated that failing to so serve the State Government, petitioner shall be liable to deposit penalty amount as mentioned in the bond.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after completion of said course, petitioner applied for Senior Resident-ship (SR-ship) and was offered a seat in All India Institute Of Medical Sciences, Rishikesh, which is an Institute of National Importance.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that petitioner is in need of original documents and is ready to submit an undertaking of him serving the State of Rajasthan for the bond period after completion of his tenure at All India Institute Of Medical Sciences, Rishikesh.

6. Following directions given by this Court at Jaipur Bench in the case of **Dr. Harshpreet Kour** (supra), this Court feels that present matter requires consideration.

7. Issue notice. Issue notice of the stay application also, returnable within a period of six weeks.

8. In the meantime, respondents are directed to release original document(s) of petitioner immediately, on petitioner furnishing an undertaking to the effect that he would serve State

of Rajasthan for the period stipulated in the service bond executed by him, after completion of his tenure of SR-ship at All India Institute Of Medical Sciences, Rishikesh.

9. Said undertaking shall also state that in the event he fails to serve State Government, he would pay the penalty amount to State Government as mentioned in the bond.

10. Copy of such undertaking shall also be filed before this Court and be made part of record.

11. It is made clear that if petitioner fails to qualify interview or for any other reason, fails to join All India Institute Of Medical Sciences, Rishikesh, Uttarakhand, he would mandatorily handover his original document(s) to State Government within a period of seven days from said rejection of / non-joining by petitioner.

12. Respondent No. 5 – AIIMS, Rishikesh is expected to consider candidature of petitioner for SR-ship as offered to him in case said offer/admission is not already cancelled.

13. List the matter after six weeks.
