1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has participated in the selection process for appointment on the post of Assistant Professor (Business Administration). He submits that in the Advertisement dated 22.06.2023 (Annex.1), there is a specific condition mentioned that: "*A person who has appeared or is appearing in the final year examination of the required educational qualification for the said posts will also be eligible to apply, but they must provide proof of acquiring the educational qualification before the interview conducted by the Commission.*"

Note: The expression "before the interview" means the date on which the interview process begins (the first day of the interview)."

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was issued a mark-sheet for the Post Graduation in Business Administration for the previous post on 08.09.2023 and for the final year examination on 17.08.2024. He submits that the petitioner's candidature has been rejected by the respondents on 22.01.2026 (Annex.7), indicating in it that the petitioner had not taken admission in the final year of the Post Graduation course before the last date of receipt of the application form i.e. 31.07.2023. He submits that the said rejection is arbitrary and not in consonance with the conditions laid down in the advertisement; wherein, an appearing candidate is also permitted to participate in the selection process.

3. Issue notice of the writ petition along with stay application to the respondents, returnable within a period of four weeks.

4. In the meanwhile, respondents shall permit the petitioner to participate in the subsequent selection process/interview, however, the participation shall not create any equity in favour of the petitioner.
