1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondents while rejecting the candidature of the petitioner through communication dated 02.01.2026 (Annex.7) on the ground that the petitioner is having colour vision deficiency, also granted petitioner an opportunity to get himself examined by a Government Medical Officer and produce a report. He submits that the petitioner got himself examined at Rajkiya Mahatma Gandhi Jila Chikitsalaya, District Banswara (Annex.8) as well as Sawai Mansingh Hospital, Jaipur (Annex.9) and the concerned doctor opined that the petitioner is not suffering from colour deficiency. He submits that the said reports were also communicated to the respondents, however, vide communication dated 29.01.2026 (Annex.10), the respondents again rejected candidature of the petitioner on the

same ground taking into consideration a report dated 28.01.2026. He submits that since there is a discrepancy in the medical report, petitioner may be permitted to get himself examined by an independent doctor/medical board.

2. Mr. Ritu Raj Singh Bhati, learned GC, puts in appearance on behalf of respondent – Home Department.

3. Counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply copy of the writ petition to Mr. Ritu Raj Singh Bhati, learned GC during the course of the day.

4. The Director, AIIMS is directed to constitute a Medical Board consisting of at least two Medical Officers for examining the petitioner's fitness qua the deficiency as pointed out by the respondents.

5. Petitioner shall hand over a Demand Draft of Rs.15,000/- (Fifteen Thousand Only) in the name of "Rajasthan State Legal Services Authority, Jodhpur" on or before 22.02.2026. Petitioner shall further produce a certified copy of the order instant along with the proof of having tendered the Demand Draft in favour of Rajasthan State Legal Services Authority, Jodhpur to Mr. Ritu Raj Singh Bhati, learned GC.

6. Report of the Medical Board constituted at AIIMS, Jodhpur, shall be produced before this Court in a sealed cover by the next date.

7. List on 24.02.2026, after reflecting name of Mr. Ritu Raj Singh Bhati, learned GC in the cause list from the respondents' side.
