1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a suit filed by respondent in respect of same land was dismissed, and in said suit, petitioner, being brother of family member, had been impleaded as party-defendant.
2. After dismissal of said suit, an appeal under Section 75 of the Rajasthan Land Revenue Act was preferred by the same persons, however, present petitioner was not impleaded as party-respondent. An application filed under Order 1 Rule 10 CPC was rejected, and revision petition filed against the same was also rejected.
3. Matter requires consideration.
4. Issue notice. Issue notice of the stay application also, returnable within a period of four weeks.
5. In the meantime, further proceedings in Appeal No. 61/2022 shall remain stayed.
