1. Learned counsel for the petitioner makes a limited prayer that the petitioner Institution has preferred an application before the respondents for the purpose of grant of NOC for B.Sc. Nursing Course for the academic session 2025-26. He submits that till date, the respondents have not processed the application filed by the petitioner (Annex.2). He submits that the respondents may be directed to decide the said applications in a time bound manner,

as the next round of counselling would be conducted in a short time and the petitioner Institution would be deprived of running the aforesaid course.

2. Thus, in view of the limited submissions made, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the respondents to decide the application filed by the petitioner – Institution at Annex.2 for the purpose of grant of NOC for the B.Sc. Nursing, strictly in accordance with law after taking into consideration all the requisites required to be fulfilled by the petitioner - Institution within a period of '60 days' from the date of receipt of the said order.

3. Accordingly, the writ petition is **disposed of**. Stay application as well as any other pending application, if any, also stand disposed of.

4. It is made clear that this order does not indicate the application of the petitioner be decided in a particular manner. The respondents are required to examine the documents and decide strictly in accordance with law.
