1. Present writ petition is filed challenging the order dated 04.02.2026 to the extent the demand has been created as against the petitioner and subsequent recovery order dated 30.02.2026 (Annex. 10) was issued.
2. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that in spite of informing the respondent – Department on several occasions with

regard to the new and correct address, the show-cause notices were being sent on the old address. Thus, the action taken by respondent was in violation of principles of natural justice.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that although the appellate authority has taken into account the said fact and restored the mining lease of petitioner, however, the penalty to the extent of five times of the amount has been imposed upon the petitioner.

4. Matter requires consideration.

5. Issue notice. Issue notice of stay application also, returnable within a period of six weeks.

6. In the meantime, order impugned dated 04.02.2026 so also the order dated 13.02.2026 to the extent of recovery from the petitioner shall remain stayed.
