1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that Condition No. 8 contained in the Expression of Interest (EOI) issued by the Municipal Council, Churu for running 'Shri Annapurna Rasoi' is contrary to Clause No. 2.7 of the guidelines issued by the Local Self Government Department, Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur. It was contended that the said guidelines, governing the operation of 'Shri Annapurna Rasoi', do not stipulate that a society/sansthan cannot be allotted more than one Rasoi/Kitchen.
2. The matter requires consideration.
3. Issue notices. Issue notice of the stay application as well.

4. In the meanwhile, if the petitioner–society/sansthan submits a bid for allotment of more than one Rasoi/Kitchen pursuant to the EOI issued by the Municipal Council, Churu, the same shall be considered. However, in the event the petitioner–society/sansthan is found eligible for allotment of more than one Rasoi/Kitchen, such allotment shall be made in its favour subject to the final outcome of the present writ petition.
