1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondent No.6 the Village Development Officer, Gram Panchayat Rohidala, Panchayat Samiti, Gadra Road, District Barmer regarding



the due payment of salary for the period starting from December, 2023 to the present date.

2. In view of the aforesaid, the present writ petition is disposed of with the direction to the petitioner to file a fresh representation within a period of two weeks along with the photo copy of the representation and certified copy of the order instant. In case a representation is submitted within aforesaid period, the respondent No.6 shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law as early as possible preferably within eight weeks thereafter.

3. It is made clear that aforesaid direction to decide the representation has been issued only with a view to ensure expeditious redressal of petitioner's grievance. The same may not be construed to be an order to decide the representation in a particular manner.

4. The stay application also stands disposed of accordingly.
