Order

1. There has been a counter case of the same incident lodged at the instance of two rivalry parties who quote two different narratives. The instant one in which order framing charges has been impugned is triable by Court of Session and the other is triable by Court of Magistrate.

2. It is stated at the bar that the counter case is pending before the Nyaya Adhikari, Gram Nyayalaya Rajgarh, District Churu.
3. I am of the view that a counter case must be tried together, the evidence must be recorded simultaneously or in close proximity and whereafter should be decided by the same judge, but with two separate judgments.
4. The enunciation of the law in this regard has been made by this Court vide order dated 10.02.2026 in the case of **Amin Khan S/o Rahim Khan & Anr. Vs. State of Rajasthan** in S.B. Criminal Revision Petition No. 188/2026.
5. Issue notice, returnable after four weeks.
6. In the meanwhile further proceeding pending in the Court of Add. Sessions Judge, No.1, Rajgarh, District Churu in Sessions Case No.22/2023 shall remain stayed.
7. By exercising suo moto revisional jurisdiction vested in this regard, further proceeding arising out of FIR No.85/2023, Police Station Hameervas, District Churu, bearing case No.1039/2023 before Gram Adhikari, Gram Nyayalaya Rajgarh, District Churu shall also remain stayed.
