Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondents, vide order dated 25.08.2020, placed the petitioner under suspension while invoking Rule 13 of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1958. He further submits that the petitioner continues to remain under suspension till date and has not been reinstated so far, which is contrary to the settled position of law as laid down in Ajay Kumar Choudhary Vs. Union of India through its Secretary & Ors. (2015) 7 SCC 291 where it has been held that suspension of the governing servant shall not extend beyond the period of three months if within this period, the charge-sheet is not served upon the delinquent employee.

Issue notice to the respondents. Issue notice of stay petition as well.

Additionally, learned counsel for the petitioner would be at liberty to supply copy of the writ petition to the concerned counsel.
