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**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE KULDEEP MATHUR**

**Order**

**24/02/2026**

1. By way of filing the present writ petition, the petitioners have prayed for the following reliefs:-

*"It is, therefore, most humbly and respectfully prayed that this petition for writ in the nature of mandamus may kindly be accepted & allowed; and*

*1. By an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, the respondent authorities may kindly be directed to Immediately remove the encroachment made on Khasra No.*

*1411, 1412 in village Dawal, Tehsil Chitalwana. District Jalore by dispossessing them and restore the original position of the said land to the petitioners.*

*2. The cost of this writ petition may kindly be awarded to the petitioner.*

*3. Any, other writ order or direction which this Hon'ble Court deem just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case may kindly be issued in favour of the petitioners."*

2. After arguing the matter for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioners would be satisfied if the Additional Superintendent of Police, Sanchore is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 29.01.2026 submitted by the petitioner.

3. In view of aforesaid limited submission made at Bar, this Court deems it just and proper to dispose of the present writ petition with a direction to Additional Superintendent of Police, Sachore to consider and decide the representation dated 29.01.2026 submitted by the petitioners in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible.

4. It is made clear that the aforesaid direction to decide the representation has been issued only with a view to expeditious redressal of petitioners' grievances and the same may not be construed to be an order to decide the representation in a particular manner.

5. Stay petition and all pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
