**Order**

1. The petitioner has filed this bail application under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.14/2026 registered at Police Station Pallu, District Hanumangarh for offence under Sections 19/54, 54A, 54D of Rajasthan Excise Act.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the allegation against the petitioner for possessing 1503 cartons of english liquor without any valid permit. He again submits that the petitioner is behind the bars since 02.02.2026 with one criminal antecedent of similar nature. He further argued that the offences are triable by Magistrate and the trial of the case may take considerable time and no further custodial interrogation is

required, hence the bail application of the petitioner may be allowed.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application.

5. On consideration of the rival submissions and material available on record and in the light of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioner.

6. Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner **Prakash Kumar S/o Laduram**, be released on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that he shall appear before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing till conclusion of the trial.
