Order

1. The present writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed seeking quashing of FIR No. 204/2025 registered at Police Station Industrial Area, Pali. The matter was taken up and arguments were advanced to some extent. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners, seeks permission to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to submit a detailed representation before the concerned Superintendent of Police ventilating their grievances in respect of the subject FIR.

2. In view of the statement so made, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

3. Stay petition is disposed of.

4. It is directed that in the event the petitioners appear before the concerned Superintendent of Police and submit a representation along with all relevant documents within a period of 30 days from today, the concerned Superintendent of Police shall afford personal audience to the petitioners, consider the submissions raised in the representation as well as the material placed on record, and thereafter pass appropriate directions to the Investigating Officer strictly in accordance with law. The concerned Superintendent of Police shall ensure that the investigation is conducted fairly and that no injustice is caused to the petitioners.

3. It is further directed that, in the interregnum, and until the representation so submitted is considered and appropriate orders are passed thereon, the petitioner shall not be arrested in connection with FIR No.204/2025 registered at Police Station Industrial Area, Pali.

4. This order has been passed solely to safeguard the liberty of the petitioners and to enable them to place their version before the higher police authorities. It is clarified that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the allegations contained in the FIR.
