1. The instant bail application has been filed under Section 483 BNSS on behalf of accused-petitioner. The accused-petitioner has been arrested in connection with FIR No.24/2026 registered at Police Station Begun, District Chittorgarh for the offence(s) under Section 8/15 of the NDPS Act.
2. Learned counsel for the accused-petitioner submits that the accused-petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. It is contended that the recovered quantity of poppy straw is 41 kg 450 gram, which is below commercial quantity and charge-sheet has already been submitted and there are no criminal antecedents against the accused-petitioner. The accused-petitioner is in custody since long and trial of the case may take considerable

time, therefore, the bail application of the accused-petitioner may be allowed.

3. The learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application.

4. Heard and perused the material available on record.

5. Considering the arguments advanced by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, this Court deems it just and proper to enlarge the accused-petitioner on bail.

6. Accordingly, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioner- **Hadmana Ram S/o Shri Gordhan Ram Vishnoi**, in connection with FIR No.24/2026 registered at Police Station Begun, District Chittorgarh, shall be enlarged on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for his appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
