1. Counsel representing the petitioners submits that the controversy involved in the writ petition is identical to the case of **"Executive Director, M/s Ambuja Cements Limited Rabriyawas v. Jodharam & Anr."** passed in SBCWP No.1861/2026 (with other connected matters); wherein, the Coordinate Bench has granted interim relief while issuing notices.

The said order is reproduced hereunder:

"1. The present writ petitions have been filed by the petitioner company challenging the rejection order dated 30.10.2025, whereby the application filed by the petitioner company before the Industrial Tribunal and Labour Court, Jodhpur Metro (Rajasthan) has been rejected.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that similar controversy is pending before the Division Bench of this Court at Jaipur Bench, which is in regards to the consequences of the Repealing and Amending Act, 2016 and the Division Bench has passed an interim order staying the proceedings pending before the Labour Court in **Chief**

Manager, RSRTC vs. Madan Lal Gurjar & Ors.: D.B. Special Appeal (Writ) No. 249/2023 on 08.05.2023.

3. In light of the aforesaid interim order passed by the Division Bench, the proceedings pending before the Labour Court, as relating to the present case, are stayed till further orders.
 4. Admit.
 5. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable in four weeks.
 6. List these matters on **27.03.2026.**"
2. In view of the above, issue notice of the writ petition along with stay application to the respondents.
3. In the meanwhile and until next date, the proceedings pending before the Labour Court, as relating to the present case, shall remain stayed.
4. Connect with SBCWP No.1861/2026, as prayed.
