1. Learned counsel for the parties jointly submitted that the controversy involved in the present writ petition is akin to the controversy involved in S.B. CWP No.9180/2025 titled as "Sunita Rani vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors."
2. The co-ordinate Bench of this Court in the case of 'Sunita Rani' has directed the respondent authorities to consider the application of the petitioner as filed for issuance of an EWS certificate if the petitioner complies with all the other conditions as prescribed for issuance of an EWS certificate.

3. In view of the aforesaid joint submission made at Bar, this Court deems it just and proper to dispose of the present civil writ petition with a direction to the respondent authorities to consider the application of the petitioner for issuance of EWS certificate if the petitioner complies with the other directions within a period of four weeks from today.

4. It is made clear that early rejection of the application would not preclude the competent authority from reconsidering the application.

5. Stay petition and all pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
