1. By way of filing the present writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for the following reliefs:-

"In view of the facts and grounds stated above, it is therefore, most respectfully prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to:

- i. Issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ directing the Respondents to issue Patta in favour of the Petitioners, in accordance with law and the will dated 11.10.2023; (Annex.6)*
- ii. Direct Respondent no. 1 and 2 to decide the Petitioners representation within a stipulated time frame;*
- iii. Pass any other writ, order or direction which this Hon'ble Court may deems just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, in favour of the humble Petitioner."*

2. After arguing the matter for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied if he

is permitted to submit a representation before Respondent No. 3 – the Village Development Officer (VDO), for redressal of his grievances.

3. In view of the aforesaid, the present writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a representation before Respondent No. 3 – the Village Development Officer (VDO), who shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt thereof.

4. It is made clear that the aforesaid direction to decide the petitioner's representation has been issued only with a view to ensure expeditious redressal of his grievances, and the same shall not be construed as a direction to decide the representation in any particular manner.

5. With the aforesaid directions, the present writ petition as well as the stay application stand disposed of.
