1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that by way of original order dated 31.07.1997, the allotments made in favour of various individuals were cancelled. It is further submitted that the legal representatives of Shri Mangi Lal, son of Shri Hajari Gurjar, who was also a party to the said proceedings culminating in the order dated 31.07.1997, have filed S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 7365/2024, wherein this Court has issued notice and has also directed the parties to maintain status quo with regard to the subject piece of land.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that controversy involved in the present case is similar to the issue raised in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 7365/2024.
3. Matter requires consideration.
4. Issue notice. Issue notice of stay application also, returnable within a period of four weeks.
5. In the meanwhile, status quo with regard to the possession of the petitioner on the subject piece of land as exist today, shall remain stayed by all the parties.
6. List the matter after four weeks along with S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 7365/2024.
