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**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE KULDEEP MATHUR**

**Order**

**25/02/2026**

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that despite the petitioner being in possession of the disputed land and holding a valid patta along with due permission to raise construction thereon, the Gram Vikas Adhikari, Gram Panchayat Bagore, Panchayat Samiti (Mandal), District Bhilwara, has issued a notice dated 05.02.2026 alleging that the petitioner has encroached upon the land and directed him to remove the alleged encroachment.

2. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court deems it just and proper to dispose of the present writ petition

with a direction to the respondent to file a detailed reply along with documents to the notice dated 05.02.2026 (Annexure-4) within a period of 15 days from the date of this order.

3. The Gram Vikas Adhikari, Gram Panchayat Bagore, Panchayat Samiti (Mandal), District Bhilwara, shall consider the said representation sympathetically and objectively and thereafter pass a reasoned and speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt thereof.

4. It is made clear that until the representation submitted by the petitioner against the notice dated 05.02.2026 (Annexure-4) issued by the Gram Vikas Adhikari, Gram Panchayat Bagore, Panchayat Samiti (Mandal), District Bhilwara, is decided, no coercive action to dispossess the petitioner from the land in dispute shall be taken.

5. It is further made clear that in case the representation is decided against the petitioner, the petitioner shall be at liberty to approach the appropriate legal forum for redressal of his grievances.

6. The stay petition and all pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
