1. The petitioner has filed this bail application under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.33/2026 registered at Police Station Jasarasar, District Bikaner for offence under Section 19/54 of Rajasthan Excise Act.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the present petitioner is that from his conscious possession, 22 plastic quarters; 20 plastic quarters bearing the label "Royal Challenge Whisky" (180 ml); 15 plastic quarters marked "Signature Whisky" (180 ml); 10 glass quarters labeled "Royal Swag Deluxe"; and other quarters of different categories containing English liquor, in total, 151.7 litres, comprising 223 English quarters, 217 country-made quarters, 62 English half bottles, and 12 beer bottles, were recovered and the petitioner

was selling these without having any valid license. He again submits that the present case is triable by Magistrate. The petitioner is behind the bars since 14.02.2026 without any criminal past. The trial of the case may take considerable time and no further custodial interrogation is required. Hence, the bail application of the petitioner may be allowed.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application.

5. On consideration of the rival submissions and material available on record and in the light of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioner.

6. Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner **Sukh Ram Alias Sukharam S/o Shri Mala Ram**, be released on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that he shall appear before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing till conclusion of the trial.
