1. The petitioner has filed this bail application under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.19/2026 registered at Police Station Gangrar, District Chittorgarh for offence under Section 8/21 of NDPS Act and Section 16/54 of Rajasthan Excise Act.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that recovered contraband is 6 grams smack which is below the commercial quantity, alongwith 2.735 ml. illicit liquor. Counsel further submits that the petitioner is about 65 years of age and has been behind bars since 04.02.2026. Though another case of a different nature is pending against him in which he has already been granted bail. The trial of the case may take considerable time and no further custodial interrogation is

required, hence the bail application of the petitioner may be allowed.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application.

5. On consideration of the rival submissions and material available on record and in the light of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner **Jagdish S/o Tulsi Ram Banjara**, be released on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that he shall appear before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing till conclusion of the trial.
