1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner has furnished his reply alongwith copies of requisite documents before the respondent No. 6 – Naib Tehsildar, Tonkarwad, District Bhilwara, but instead of deciding the same, the respondents are going to dispossess the petitioner and a notice dated 16.02.2026 has been issued.

2. Issue notice. Issue notice of stay application also, returnable in six weeks.
3. Meanwhile, it will be required of the petitioner to produce a certified copy of the order instant before the Naib Tehsildar, Tonkarwad, District Bhilwara alongwith photocopy of his earlier representation dated 17.02.2026, which is claimed to have been filed before the Naib Tehsildar, Tonkarwad, District Bhilwara and a certified copy of this order within seven days from today.
4. It shall be required of respondent no. 6 - Naib Tehsildar, Tonkarwad, District Bhilwara to consider petitioner's representation in accordance with law within four weeks.
5. In case, the respondent no. 6 finds the petitioner's possession and title to be in accordance with law, he shall not dispossess the petitioner. Else he will pass speaking order under intimation to the petitioner and give at least fifteen days notice to vacate the possession.
6. The petitioner shall, however, not be dispossessed by the next date of hearing.
