1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was engaged with the respondents from 01.05.2015 working on the post of Computer Operator on contractual basis and the petitioner continued to work with the respondents for good ten years, however, the petitioner has not been verbally discontinued from service without assigning any reason. He submits that the neither the petitioner was served with any prior notice nor he has been afforded any opportunity of hearing before discontinuing of his services. He also submits that petitioner's services have not been replaced by a regularly selected candidate.

2. In view of the submissions made, issue notice to the respondents. Issue notice of the stay application as well. Rule is made returnable within four weeks.

3. In the meanwhile, the respondents are directed to permit the petitioner to continue to discharge his duties on the post of Computer Operator as prior to verbal discontinuance of his services, in case the petitioner's services are not replaced by a regularly selected candidate.
