1. The petitioner has preferred this bail application under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.50/2026 registered at Police Station Suratgarh City, District Sri Ganganagar for offence under Sections 8/21 and 25 of NDPS Act.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that allegation against the present petitioner is that he is supplier of the alleged contraband weighing 20 grams Heroin (*smack*), which is below commercial quantity, and the same has been recovered from conscious possession of co-accused Gagan Deep who has been enlarged on bail by this Court on 16.02.2026. The petitioner is behind the bars since 21.01.2026. Though, one case of similar

nature has been reported against the present petitioner, in which he has been bailed out. The trial of the case will take considerable time, no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in further custody, hence, on the ground of parity, the bail application of the petitioner may be allowed.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application.

5. On consideration of the rival submissions and material available on record and in the light of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, especially on the ground of parity, but without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioner.

6. Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner **Kamar Jeet S/o Chand Singh**, be released on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that he shall appear before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing till conclusion of the trial.
