**Order**

1. The present bail application has been filed by the accused-applicant under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S., 2023 against the order dated 21.06.2025 passed by learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Desuri District Pali arising out of FIR No.16/2025, registered at Police Station Sadri, District Pali for the offences punishable under Section 309(6) of BNS, by which the bail application of the accused-applicant under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S., 2023 has been dismissed.
2. Learned counsel for the accused-applicant submits that the accused-applicant has falsely been implicated in this case. Learned counsel also submits that the accused-applicant has been charged with offence punishable under Section 309(6) of the BNS. Learned counsel further submits that the charge-sheet has been

filed against the present accused-applicant and the offence is triable by Judicial Magistrate.

3. Learned counsel for the accused-applicant contends that the accused-applicant was arrested on 16.02.2025 and since then, he is behind the bars. Learned counsel also contends that the charge-sheet has already been filed and trial will take long time to conclude, therefore, the accused-applicant be granted benefit of bail.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor vehemently opposes the bail application and submits that 12 other criminal cases have also been registered against the accused-applicant. Therefore, considering his criminal antecedents, he should not be enlarged on bail.

5. Heard learned counsel for the parties and also perused the material available on record.

6. Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the case, looking to the period of custody of the accused-applicant; the fact that the charges levelled against the accused-applicant are triable by Judicial Magistrate; that the charge-sheet has been filed and trial will take long time to conclude, without expressing any opinion on the merits/demerits of the case, this Court deems it proper to allow the bail application filed by the applicant.

7. Consequently, this bail application filed under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S., 2023 is allowed. It is ordered that accused-applicant **Vishal S/o Ummed Singh** arrested in connection with FIR No.16/2025, registered at Police Station Sadri, District Pali shall be released on bail; provided he furnishes personal bond in the

sum of Rs.1,00,000/- and two solvent attested sureties of Rs.50,000/- each to the satisfaction of the trial Court. Applicant shall be required to appear before that Court on all dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
