1. The petitioners have preferred this bail application under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.13/2026 registered at Police Station Ratannagar, District Churu for offence under Sections 19/54 of Rajasthan Excise Act, 1959.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that as per allegation from joint possession of petitioners, 360 bottles of illicit liquor have been recovered having no valid licence. The case is exclusively triable by Magistrate. Petitioners are behind the bars since 05.02.2025, without any criminal past.

The trial of the case may take considerable time, therefore, no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioners in further custody, hence, the bail application of the petitioners may be allowed.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application.

5. On consideration of the rival submissions and material available on record and in the light of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioners, but without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioners.

6. Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is directed that the petitioners **Rajesh Alias Kalu S/o Shri Mahavir and Sumit Alias Suraj S/o Shri Satpal**, be released on bail provided each of them furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that they shall appear before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing till conclusion of the trial.
