1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a raid was conducted under the supervision of Shri Karan Singh, who was posted at the time incident the on post of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sangaria and charge-sheet had also been issued to him, however, till date he is allowing to discharge duties at field, whereas, due to issuance of charge-sheet, the petitioner is not giving field posting.

2. Learned counsel representing the petitioner, at the outset, makes a limited submission that petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents No.4 and 5 i.e. Inspector General Of Police, Bikaner Range, Bikaner and Superintendent Of Police, Hanumangarh, may be directed to consider and decide the representation to be filed petitioner by way of passing a speaking order, strictly in accordance with law within a particular time period.

3. In light of such limited submission, it is hereby directed that the petitioner shall submit a detailed representation to the respondents No.4 and 5 for ventilating her grievances within a period of '15 days' from today. The representation of the petitioner shall be decided by such respondents by way of passing a speaking order strictly in accordance with law within a period of 'four weeks' from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
4. With the aforesaid direction, the instant writ petition is disposed of. Stay application as well as all other pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.
