1. Heard.
2. The petitioner happens to be a victim of FIR No.332/2024 dated 17.08.2024 of Police Station Bhinmal, District Jalore. A detailed factual report dated 04.02.2026 prepared by Additional SP, Crime and Vigilance Range, Jodhpur and addressed to ACJM, Bhinmal, Jalore clearly revealing that the investigation has been concluded after conducting thorough investigation and whereupon involvement of accused Shanti Lal Chittora and Chirag Chittora found proved for committing offence under Section 318(4), 316(2), 61(2)(A) of BNS and supervisory instruction for filing

charge-sheet has also been obtained by Challan No.224 dated 01.09.2025.

In this view of the matter, the instant writ petition is disposed of and the Superintendent of Police, IG Range, Jodhpur and the Superintendent of Police, Jalore and directed to make sure that the result as mentioned in the factual report dated 04.02.2026 shall forthwith be submitted before the Magistrate having territorial jurisdiction to entertain within a period of 30 days after receipt of a copy of this order.
