1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in similar controversy, a Coordinate Bench of this Court has granted interim order on 17.02.2026 in SBCWP No.3627/2026, while issuing notices.

2. The order dated 27.02.2026 is reproduced hereunder:

“1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was promoted from post of Patwari to post of Senior Patwari vide order dated 28.02.2023 (Annexure-3), and his name was duly confirmed for said promotion in the DPC held on 15.02.2023.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner is well placed in the seniority list and has been discharging duties on promoted post for the last four years, however, his promotion has been cancelled without affording any opportunity of hearing to petitioner by order dated 03.02.2026 (Annexure-7), in view of Second Review DPC.

3. Learned counsel submits that said order, which effectively amounts to reversion of petitioner, has been passed in violation of principles of natural justice, as no opportunity of hearing was granted to him.

4. Matter requires consideration.

5. Issue notice. Issue notice of the stay application also, returnable within a period four weeks.

6. In the meantime, effect and operation of impugned order dated 03.02.2026 shall remain stayed qua the petitioner.”

3. In view of the above, issue notice. Issue notice of the stay application as well.

4. In the meanwhile, effect and operation of the impugned order dated 03.02.2026 shall remain stayed qua the petitioner.

5. Connect with SBCWP No.3627/2026, as prayed.
