1. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the instant criminal writ petition. However, he seeks liberty for the petitioner to submit a representation to the concerned Superintendent of Police with appropriate directions to decide the same and issue necessary instructions to the concerned Investigating Officer.
2. Accordingly, the instant criminal writ petition as well as stay petition are dismissed as not pressed with liberty to the petitioner to submit a detailed representation to the concerned Superintendent of Police averring therein all the grounds which have been raised in this petition within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

3. In the event, the representation is submitted, the Superintendent of Police, Rajsamand is directed to minutely and objectively consider the contents of the same and thereafter, issue necessary instructions to the Investigating Officer. All the relevant documents with the representation shall also be taken into consideration. The representation shall be decided within a period of 40 days from the date of receipt of the same. Till then, no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner in connection with FIR No.46/2026 registered at the Police Station Railmagra, District Rajsamand.
