1. Upon observance of the facts of the case it is reflecting that the fact recited in the parcha kayami report are distinct to the real time which is evident from the GPS report for which an order was passed by the learned Magistrate. There is a dichotomy as well as in-congruence at the very inception of a criminal case and the plea

that a false case has been foisted and fake and sham memos were prepared has a substance.

2. Issue notice.
3. Learned PP accepts notice for State, thus issue notice to private respondent.
4. Learned PP would require to file reply.
5. List the matter after three weeks.
6. Heard on stay application.
7. In view of the existence of strong prima facie case in favour of the petitioner and noticing serious discrepancies in real time and the time recited in the memos, the stay application is allowed.
8. It is ordered that till disposal of the main petition, further proceeding in Sessions Case No.44/2025 pending before learned Special Judge, NDPS Cases, Rawatsar, District Hanumangarh shall remain stayed.
