1. The petitioners have filed these bail applications under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.13/2026 registered at Police Station Churu Sadar, District Sadar for offence under Section 8/18 of NDPS Act.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. He further

submits that the allegation against the petitioners is that 1.968 Killograms opium has been recovered from the joint possession of the petitioners, which is below commercial quantity. He again submits that the petitioners are behind the bars since 13.02.2026 and one other antecedent has been reported against the petitioner-Omprakash, which is of similar nature and the same is pending. The trial of the case may take considerable time and no further custodial interrogation is required, hence the bail applications of the petitioners may be allowed.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail applications.

5. On consideration of the rival submissions and material available on record and in the light of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioners but without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bails to the petitioners.

6. Consequently, the bail applications under Section 483 B.N.S.S. are allowed and it is directed that the petitioners **(1) Omprakash S/o Baburam & (2) Mahipal S/o Mohan Ram**, be released on bail provided they furnish a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- each with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that they shall appear before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing till conclusion of the trial.
