1. The petitioner has preferred this bail application under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.15/2026 registered at Police Station Rathanjana, District Pratapgarh for offence under Sections 8/15 and 8/29 of NDPS Act.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that allegation against the petitioner is that he was sitting as pillion rider in the escorting vehicle involved in the offence. He argued that nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the present petitioner and the contraband 80Kg 640 grams of Poppy straw (*Doda Chura*), which is below commercial quantity has been recovered from co-accused laxman. The petitioner is behind the bars since 27.01.2026, without any criminal past. The

trial of the case will take considerable time, no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in further custody, hence, the bail application of the petitioner may be allowed.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application.

5. On consideration of the rival submissions and material available on record and in the light of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, but without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioner.

6. Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner **Faizan S/o Dadu**, be released on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that he shall appear before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing till conclusion of the trial.
