1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the matter involving similar controversy, has been disposed of by a Coordinate Bench of this Court in the case of ***Zabir Khan vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors (SBCWP No.1964/2022)*** decided on 14.03.2022 & other connected petitions. He submits that the present writ petition may also be disposed of in the same terms.

2. In view of the above, the writ petition stands **disposed of** while directing the petitioners to submit a representation for redressal of their grievance within 10 days from today and the same shall be decided within a period of 30 days thereafter, by passing a reasoned and speaking order, which shall be communicated to the petitioners/vehicle owners. Further for renewal of permit/fitness certificate/registration certificate or of transfer of registration certificate, the respondents shall proceed in accordance with the statutory provisions contained under the Motor Vehicle Act, 1998 without being influenced by the fact that the petitioners' vehicles have been classified as "Blocked".
