1. The petitioners has filed this bail application under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.15/2026 registered at Police Station Dudwakhara, District Churu for offence under Sections 8/18 of NDPS Act.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits contraband weighing 970 grams of Opium, which is less than the commercial quantity, was alleged to be recovered from the joint possession of

the petitioners. He argued that no criminal antecedents exists against the petitioners. He again submits that the petitioners are behind the bars since 16.02.2026, the trial of the case will take considerable time, therefore, no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioners in further custody and the bail application of the petitioners may be allowed.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application.

5. On consideration of the rival submissions and material available on record and in the light of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioners but without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioners.

6. Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is directed that the petitioners **Jaswant Singh S/o Bhanupratap Singh, Ugaram S/o Hamirram Nayak** and **Devaram S/o Ambaram Kumhar** be released on bail provided each of them furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that they shall appear before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing till conclusion of the trial.
