1. The present application has been filed under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S. seeking extension of interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 21.01.2026 passed in S.B. Criminal Miscellaneous Bail Application No. 935/2026.

2. By the aforesaid order, the petitioner was enlarged on interim bail for a period of forty days on humanitarian grounds, primarily in view of the serious medical condition of his mother and the proposed surgical procedure. It is averred in the present application that the surgery could not be performed earlier as the patient was not found medically fit at that time. It is further submitted that the operation is now scheduled to be undertaken and the petitioner's presence is necessary to provide care and support during the surgery and immediate recovery period.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor has been heard.

4. Having considered the submissions and the material placed on record, and taking note of the limited nature of the relief sought, this Court is satisfied that sufficient cause has been shown for grant of a short extension of interim bail.

5. Accordingly, the application is allowed. The interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 21.01.2026 in S.B. Criminal Miscellaneous Bail Application No. 935/2026 is extended for a further period of thirty (30) days from the date of expiry of the earlier interim bail, on the same terms and conditions as contained in the said order.

6. The petitioner shall surrender before the concerned Jail Authorities forthwith upon expiry of the extended period, failing which the authorities shall be at liberty to take steps in accordance with law.
