1. By way of the present writ petition, the petitioners have prayed for the following reliefs:

It is, therefore, most respectfully prayed that the this Writ Petition may kindly be allowed and the names of the petitioners may kindly be included in the voter list of Gram Panchayat- Meethi Beri, Balotra, Rajasthan.

It is, therefore, most respectfully prayed that the competent authority may kindly be directed to consider and the decide the application submitted by the petitioner (receipt Ann. 04) to include the name of the petitioners in the voter list of newly formed Gram Panchayat- Meethi Beri, Balotra, Rajasthan may kindly be decided within a period of 5 days after considering the documents/material submitted by the petitioners.

Any other appropriate writ, order or direction which this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, may kindly be passed in the favour of the petitioner.

Cost of the writ petition may kindly be awarded to the petitioner

2. After arguing the matter for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners would be satisfied if the District Collector, Balotra, is directed to consider and decide the representation of the petitioners seeking restoration of the names of villagers of Baldev Nagaur, Ward No. 5 in the voters list of newly formed Gram Panchayat- Meethi Beri, Balotra, Rajasthan.
3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the limited prayer made, this Court deems it just and proper to dispose of the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to file a fresh representation along with a certified copy of this order before the office of the District Collector, Balotra.
4. In the event such representation is filed, the District Collector, Balotra, shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible, preferably before issuance of the final voter list.
5. It is made clear that the aforesaid direction to decide the representation has been issued solely with a view to ensure expeditious redressal of the petitioners' grievances, and the same shall not be construed as a direction to decide the representation in a particular manner.
6. The stay petition and all pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
