1. The petitioners have preferred this bail application under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.31/2026 registered at Police Station Karanpur, District Sri Ganganagar for offence under Sections 8/21 and 25 of NDPS Act.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that from the joint possession of petitioners 115 grams of Heroin (*chitta*), which is below the commercial quantity, has been

recovered. Though against the petitioner Dilpreet Singh six cases have been reported including two cases of similar nature, against Gurpreet Singh two cases of different nature and against Anil Kumar three cases have been reported including one case of similar nature, but the petitioners are behind bars since 12.02.2026, and the trial of the case will take considerable time; therefore, no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioners in further custody, and the bail application of the petitioners may be allowed.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application.

5. On consideration of the rival submissions and material available on record and in the light of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioners but without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioners.

6. Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is directed that the petitioners **Dilpreet Singh S/o Rajdeep Singh, Gurpreet Singh @ Ravi S/o Harbans Singh and Anil Kumar S/o Krishan Lal**, be released on bail provided each of them furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that they shall appear before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing till conclusion of the trial.
