1. Heard.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in a writ
petition, involving identical controversy, being SBCWP
No.7498/2025, a Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated
17.04.2025 while issuing notices to the respondents has granted
interim order. The order dated 17.04.2025 reads as under:

"1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
in an identical writ petition being S.B. Civil Writ Petition
No.3195/2023, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide

order dated 28.02.2023 passed the following interim order:

"No assistance of lawyers is available today.

The petitioner present in person has shown the letter dated 01.07.2008, by which, they were given recruitment, in which, the age limit was 65 years. He has also referred to Rule 256 Sub Rule (E) of the Rajasthan Panchayati Raj Rules 1996.

Issue notice to the respondents, returnable within four weeks.

In the meanwhile, the respondents are directed to continue the services of the petitioner on the post of Junior Technical Assistant in Panchayat Samiti Bagora, District Jalore."

3. In view of the above, Issue notice. Issue notice of stay application also.

Notices be filed in two sets within a period of one week. On the same being filed, one set be given 'dasti' to learned counsel for the petitioner for service through registered post acknowledgment due. Notices be made returnable on 20.05.2025.

Postal receipts of the 'dasti' notices be filed within a period of one week from the date of receipt of 'dasti' notices.

4. Meanwhile, the services of the petitioner shall not be terminated."

3. Issue notice to the respondents. Issue notice of the stay petition as well.
