1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is suffering from H.I. (Hearing Impairment) disability to the extent of 90% (Annexure-2). He submits that, at the time of filling out the online application form, the petitioner inadvertently marked the column as "NA" (Not Applicable) against the specially abled category; however, he furnished the details of the disability certificate in the said application form as 2015/48. He further submits that the respondents will not consider the petitioner's candidature under the specially abled category on account of the said inadvertent error. He also submits that the petitioner has secured 28.2486 marks, whereas the cut-off for the H.I. category is 0.4139 marks.

2. Learned caveator representing the respondents prays for and is granted time to complete instructions.
3. In view of the above, issue notice of the writ petition along with stay application to the respondents. Learned caveator accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents.
4. In the meanwhile, the respondents are directed to permit the petitioner to participate in the subsequent selection process, however, the said participation shall not create any equity in her favour.
