1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the controversy involved in the writ petition is covered by the judgment passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in the case of "*Giriraj Prasad Sharma Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors.*" : SBCWP No.7603/2023, decided on 29.04.2025. He submits that the representation of the petitioners is fresh representation before the respondents and the respondents may be directed to decide the same in view of the aforesaid judgment by passing a speaking order within a particular time.

2. In view of the submissions made, the petitioners are directed to file a detailed representation within a period of '10 days' from today and the respondents are directed to decide the same by way of passing a speaking order, strictly in accordance with law, within a period of 'one month' thereafter.

3. With the aforesaid direction, the petition stands disposed of. All pending application as well as stay application, if any, also stand disposed of.
