1. The instant third bail application has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 on behalf of accused-petitioner in connection with FIR No.209/2025 registered at Police Station Rajtalab, District Banswara for the offences under Section 64(1) of BNS, 2023 and Section 66(E) Information Technology Act.
2. Heard.
3. Considered the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor and also perused the material made available on record.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that first bail application of the accused-petitioner was dismissed with a liberty to file fresh bail application after examination of the prosecutrix before the learned trial Court.

5. Learned counsel further submits that the prosecutrix has been examined as PW-3 and she has not supported the prosecution story and has been declared hostile. He also submits that the accused-petitioner is in custody since 10.11.2025.

6. Learned Public Prosecutor vehemently opposed the bail application and submits that the allegations against the accused-petitioner are of serious and grave nature.

7. Taking into consideration overall facts and circumstances of the case and more particularly the fact that the prosecutrix who has been examined as PW-3 has not supported the prosecution story and has been declared hostile, this Court without expressing any opinion on the merits or demerits of the case deems just and proper to enlarge the accused-petitioner on bail.

8. Accordingly, the third bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioner named above shall be enlarged on bail provided, he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- together with two sureties of Rs.50,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for his appearance before the Court concerned on all the dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
