Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The present writ petition has been filed with the following  
prayers :-

- "i. The writ petition may please be allowed.*
- ii. The impugned Order dated 10/09/2021 (Annexure – P/1) passed by learned Labour Court Udaipur u/S.33-C(2) of ID Act in Case No.06/2017-LCM 'Chandrashekhar Sahu Vs. Shree Rajasthan Syntex Ltd., may please be ordered to be quashed & set aside.*
- iii. The impugned Application (Annexure – P/20) filed by the respondent u/S.33-C(2) of ID Act before learned Labour Court Udaipur, may please be ordered to be dismissed.*
- iv. It may please be declared that in the present case, the respondent is not entitled to any relief*

*u/S.33-C(2) of ID Act on the basis of his continuous  
absenting throughout w.e.f. 15/02/2013, and on the  
basis of 'No Work – No Pay/Wages"*

Learned counsel for the respondent, at the very outset, submits that since the respondent has attained the age of superannuation, therefore, the order dated 10.09.2021 has lost its significance. He, therefore, submits that the writ petition may be disposed of and the order dated 10.09.2021 may be quashed.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the respondent, the order dated 10.09.2021 passed by the Labour Court, Udaipur is quashed and set aside on account of the fact that the petitioner has attained the age of superannuation.

The writ petition is disposed of in the above terms.
