1. The petitioners have preferred these bail applications under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.60/2026 registered at Police Station Phalodi, District Phalodi for offence under Sections 8/22 and 29 of NDPS Act.
2. Since both these bail applications arise out of common FIR, therefore, they are being decided by this common order.
3. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. He further

submits that allegation against the present petitioner Arshad is that he is supplier of the alleged contraband weighing 1.61 grams of MDMA, which is below commercial quantity, and the same has been recovered from conscious possession of petitioner Mahesh. The petitioners are behind the bars since 20.02.2026, without any criminal past. The trial of the case will take considerable time, no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in further custody, hence, the bail application of the petitioner may be allowed.

5. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail applications.

6. On consideration of the rival submissions and material available on record and in the light of submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners but without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bails to the petitioners.

7. Consequently, the bail applications under Section 483 B.N.S.S. are allowed and it is directed that the petitioners **Arshad S/o Shri Mujfar, Mahesh S/o Jagdish Ram**, be released on bail provided each of them furnishes a personal bail bond in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- each of the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that they shall appear before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing till conclusion of the trial.
