1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of selection process, petitioner has been appointed as Aanganwadi Helper at Aanganwadi Kendra, Dhatarwalon Ki Dhani vide order dated 29.09.2025 and petitioner has been continuously working since then. It is further submitted that another candidate - respondent No.6, preferred an appeal against the said selection process, which was rejected by the First Appellate Authority vide

order dated 22.12.2025. However, the Second Appellate Authority vide impugned order dated 13.02.2026, has directed the Selection Committee to consider the OBC Certificate of the said candidate afresh.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the direction so given by the Second Appellate Authority is not justified, as at the time of selection, the OBC certificate of respondent No.6 was not valid.

3. Matter requires consideration.

4. Issue notice. Issue notice of the stay application also, returnable within a period of four weeks.

5. In the meantime, the respondents are restrained from taking any action in pursuance of impugned order dated 13.02.2026 (Annexure-13) and the petitioner shall be permitted to discharge her duties in pursuance of her selection.
