1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present writ petition has been filed with the following prayers:-

"It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that this writ petition may kindly be allowed and by an appropriate writ, order or direction:-

(I) The Respondent may be directed to activate and verify the name/weblink of the

Petitioner Institute on the scholarship portal in order for students admitted in academic sessions 2021-2022, 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25 to avail the scholarship benefits or in the alternative the Respondents may be directed to accept the scholarship forms in offline mode.

(ii) The Respondents may may further be directed to disburse the scholarship amount to the students after accepting the scholarship forms.

(iii) Any other appropriate relief which this Hon'ble Court deems just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case may kindly be passed in favour of the petitioner.

(iv) Costs of the writ petition be also awarded in favour of the petitioner."

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a co-ordinate Bench of this Court while considering the identical issue has passed an interim order in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.5976/2025.

3. In view of the submission made above, issue notice. Issue notice of the stay application. Rule be made returnable within a period of four weeks.

4. Meanwhile, the respondents are directed to provisionally accepts petitioner's scholarship form online/offline.

5. List the matter along with S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.5976/2025.

6. Let the name of Mr. Nitish Mathur, Advocate, be shown in the cause list as counsel for the respondents.
