1. Present writ petition has been filed seeking issuance of appropriate directions to restrain respondent No. 3 from issuing a marriage registration certificate in favour of Smt. Manju.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner's son, Mukesh, has expired and that his widow is now seeking issuance of marriage registration certificate. It is contended that the widow of deceased Mukesh is an accused in FIR No. 91/2019 for an offence punishable under Section 306 IPC. On these grounds, it is argued that marriage registration certificate ought not to be issued in favor of Smt. Manju.

3. This Court is not inclined to interfere at this stage, particularly when proceedings for grant of marriage certificate are pending consideration before respondent No. 3.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, makes a limited request for issuance of directions to respondent authorities to decide the application for grant of marriage registration certificate only after due consideration of these objections raised by petitioner (Annexure-4).

5. Without commenting upon merits of the case, present writ petition is **disposed of** with direction to respondent authorities to consider and decide the application for grant of marriage registration certificate as submitted by Smt. Manju, strictly in accordance with law and after taking into account objections raised by petitioner.

6. With these observations, present writ petition is hereby **disposed of**.

7. Stay application and all pending applications, if any, stand **disposed of**.
