**Order**

In wake of onslaught of COVID-19, lawyers have been advised to refrain from coming to the Courts.

Counsel for the petitioner has invited attention to the Regulations for admission and fee structure in Private Aided and Unaided Professional Educational Institutions, 2004 issued by the University Grants Commission wherein as per para 4.16 admission to unaided professional institutions which are universities/ deemed

to be universities, the admission of candidates shall be on an all India basis without any domicile-restriction. It is his submissions that the general guidelines issued for Pre Teacher Education Test (PTET), 2020 by the respondents restricts admission to candidates from Rajasthan 95% seats as per Clause 5 of the general instructions and goes contrary to the aforesaid regulations.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a statutory university established under the Act, 2008 and would not be governed by the condition laid down by the respondents for admission to the universities for the State Government.

Issue notice of the writ petition as well as the stay application, returnable in four weeks.

In the meanwhile, the condition laid down under clause 5 of the guidelines of PTET, 2020 shall not operate as against the petitioner.
